


## **Fishlake Meadows**

A map dating from 1615 shows land in the parish of Michelmersh that was owned by Corpus Christi College in Oxford. One section of the map depicts the Test from Timsbury bridge to Greatbridge. The more southerly bridge is the smaller of the two. The leat to Greatbridge mill had not yet been built, so only a single channel needed to be crossed at this point. The Fishlake flows out of the Test on its way to Romsey. Four fields adjacent to it are located in Fishlette Meade, now part of Fishlake Meadows nature reserve. The fields are labelled with the names of their owners. George Churcher owned the northernmost of the fields and appears to have owned a building adjacent to the Fishlake. The field to the south belonged to Mr Apleforde, and then a narrow strip is labelled 'R(?) Wellinor cop.'. The next strip of land belonging to Corpus Christi College measured 0.3.14 acre-rood-perch or 0.8375 acres. Also noted is 'Douse' who is named on several other fields on the map as the tenant Thomas Douse.








The strip of Michelmersh land running west from the barge canal provides the only crossing point for Fishlake Meadows. The path has been upgraded since the creation of the nature reserve.

Another quality that underlies a number of place-names is (in)fertility of hanother quality that underlies a number of place-names is (in)fertility of the land and the effort required to till it, as assessed by the users. Field's work contains many examples of these (Field 1993; EFND). Complimentary names are few: *Canaan* Worth Matravers Do, *Land of Promise* Mx ('land flowing with milk and honey', an allusion to Exo. 3:8), *Paradise* in many counties, e.g. *Paradyse* 1380 Carlisle Cu, *Paradise* Appleton Ch, *Goshan* Odd Rode Ch and *Goshen* Uphall W Loth ('the best of the land' for cattlebreeding in Egypt, an allusion to Gen. 45–7, where Joseph's kin settled after fleeing the famine in Canaan, also later, the area untouched by the Egyptian plagues, 'a common XVIII–XIX century farm-name' standing for 'land of plenty' and 'land without plagues', see Hough 2001: 41)).<sup>18</sup> Uncomplimentary names are more common and include names referring to:

(a) places, such as the field-names *Gomorrah Close* Snaith WRY and *Sodom Field* Brampton Db, alluding to the Dead Sea and barren
